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**MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
CHAPTER 7 MEANS TEST, SCHEDULES, ATTORNEY DISCLOSURE  
STATEMENT, STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL AFFAIRS, DEBTORS DECLARATION  
PAGE, STATISTICAL SUMMARY OF SCHEDULES, SUMMARY OF SCHEDULES,  
AND STATEMENT OF INTENT**

Sean Dunne, the Debtor, by his undersigned attorneys, hereby moves for an Order pursuant to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure seeking a further extension of time to file his Chapter 7 Means Test, Schedules of Assets and Liabilities, Attorney Disclosure Statement, Statement of Financial Affairs, Debtors Declaration Page, Statistical Summary of Schedules, Summary of Schedules, and Statement of Intent as required by Rule 1007(b) (hereafter, the "Schedules") and, as ground therefore, represents:

1. On March 29, 2013 (the "Petition Date") the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief afforded by Chapter 7 of Title 11, U.S.C. in this Court.
2. Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007(b) and (c) requires that the Schedules be filed within 14 days after the Petition Date. Subsection (c) of Rule 1007 also permits an extension for the filing of Schedules on motion for cause shown and on notice to the United States Trustee or other party as the Court might direct.
3. By this Motion, Mr. Dunne seeks an extension of five additional days within which to file his Chapter 7 Means Test, Schedules of Assets and Liabilities, Attorney Disclosure

Statement, Statement of Financial Affairs, Debtors Declaration Page, Statistical Summary of Schedules, Summary of Schedules, and Statement of Intent. Although most of the information required for the Schedules has already been assembled, Mr. Dunne and his professionals require the requested extension due to the extent and complexity of Mr. Dunne's historical financial affairs and the necessity to review and translate the information already assembled into the form required by the Schedules.

4. The requested extension would make the new deadline for filing the Schedules April May 5, 2013. Mr. Dunne's first meeting of creditors is scheduled for May 8, 2013.

WHEREFORE, the Debtor respectfully requests this Court extend the deadline for the filing of the Schedules in this case to May 2, 2013 and grant such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
