

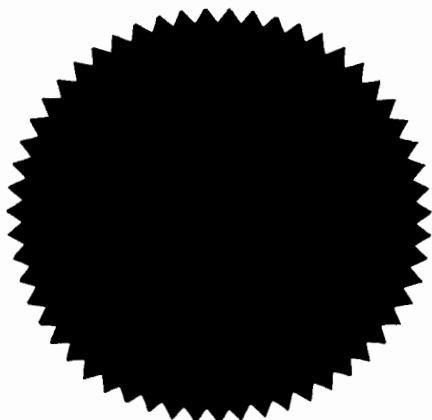

ORDER FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE OF THOMAS J. GOODWIN


